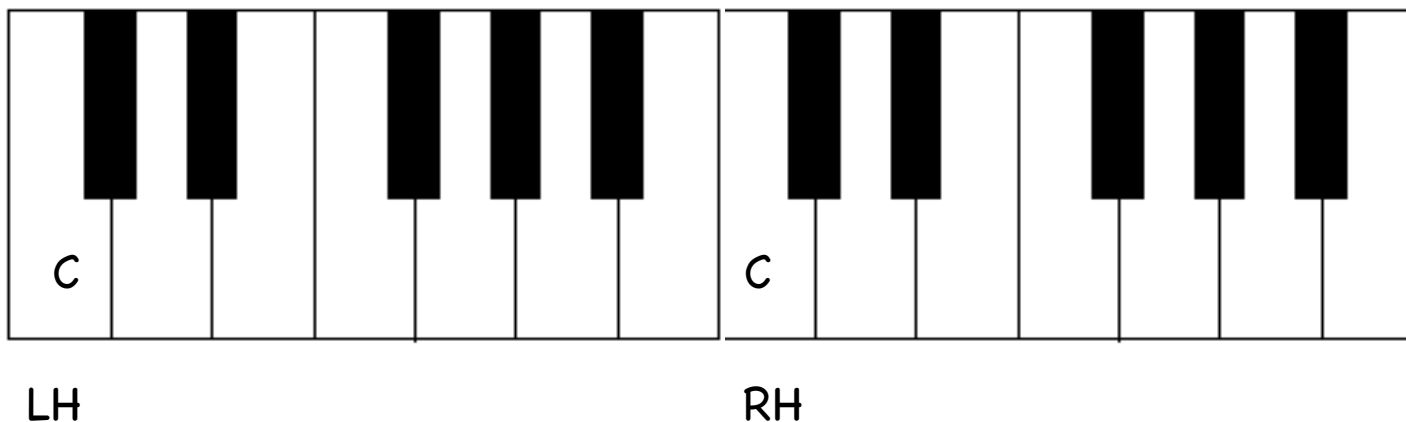


Skipped Notes Practice – Thirds

Directions: Look at the piano below. Write in letters: C, D, E, F, and G on the piano keys for both hands. Color the third between C and E on the piano **PINK** for both hands. Color the third between D and F on the piano **GREEN** for both hands. Color the third between E and G on the piano **BLUE** for both hands. Then, color the third between C and E on the music **PINK** for both hands. Color the third between D and F on the music **GREEN** for both hands. Color the third between E and G on the music **BLUE** for both hands. Then, practice playing the music in C position.
